

The following places to eat and drink are nearby in Southville or in the City Centre areas, there are many other places in the city that we haven't tried yet...

Breakfast

Central area:

Spicer+Cole at the far corner of **Queen Square** (1 Queen Square Avenue). Fresh, local ingredients, soups, salads, cakes, pastries and sandwiches. Open from 8.30am Sat & 9am Sun, it can get busy so give yourself plenty of time. **Finzels Reach**, Counterslip Bristol BS1 6BX Open from 9am Sat & Sun.

Centre Coffee Lounge, 12 Baldwin Street Unit 4, Bristol BS1 1SA. Open from 8am Sat & 9am Sunday.

Coffee#1, 51 Welsh Back, Bristol BS1 4AN. Open from 8am Saturday and 8.30am Sunday.

In the Park Street area - Woodes café at 18 Park Street (opens at 8am Sat, closed Sunday) or **Boston Tea Party** further up Park Street at no 75, opens Saturday 8am and Sunday 9am). **Pinkman's Bakery** at 85 Park Street is open from 7.30am Saturday and 8.30am Sunday.

Hart's Bakery (by Temple Meads - the road below the slope out the front of the station) Lower Approach Road Arch 35, Bristol BS1 6QS, opens 8am Sat (closed Sundays).

Wapping Wharf / Arnolfini:

Mokoko Coffee & Bakery, 2 Gaol Ferry Steps, Wapping Wharf, BS1 6WE, Saturday 8am and Sunday 9am.

Princes Pantry café and takeaway behind Arnolfini (just over the road) serving bacon sarnies, burgers, tea and coffee. Usually open 9am – 2pm Saturday and Sunday but hours often vary.

Crepe and Coffee Cabin on the bridge behind Arnolfini does excellent coffee, tea and savoury or sweet crepes – takeaway (or a couple of chairs outside) from 9am.

Harbourside:

Brunel's Buttery, doorstep bacon or sausage sandwiches, tea and coffee on the harbourside. Walk around past the MShed on the waterfront, it's just before the SS Great Britain. Open from 8am Sat & Sun (hours can vary so do check).

Pickle Cafe, Cumberland Road Underfall Yard, Bristol BS1 6XG. Open from 9am Saturday and Sunday.

Lockside, Junction Lock Cumberland Basin, Bristol BS1 6XL. (under the dual carriageway approach road. Open from 8am Sat & 9am Sun (hours can vary so do check).

Clifton area:

Spicer+Cole, Clifton Village, 9 Princess Victoria Street Bristol BS8 4DX. Open daily from 8.30am.

Rosemarino, 1 York Place, Bristol BS8 1AH. Open from 9am Saturday and Sunday.

Saffron, 4A Boyces Avenue, Bristol BS8 4AA. Open from 8am Saturday and Sunday.

Primrose Cafe, 1 Clifton Arcade Boyces Avenue, Bristol BS8 4AA. Open from 9am Saturday and 9.30am Sunday.

Budapest Cafe, 58 Alma Vale Road Clifton, Bristol BS8 2HS, Open from 9am Saturday and 9.30am Sunday.

Southville / North Street:

Tincan Coffee Co, 234 North St Bedminster, Bristol, BS3 1JD. Open Sat & Sun from 9am

Coffee#1, 247 – 249 North Street, Bedminster, Bristol BS3 1JN. Open from 8am Saturday and 8.30am Sunday.

Mark's Bread. 291 North Street, Bristol BS3 1JP. Open from 8am Saturday closed Sunday.

Sandwiches, lunch etc. at Bower Ashton

We have a canteen - Traders (pizza/burgers/buddha bowls), Student Union Cafe / Bar (homemade soup) and Costa coffee (pastries, sandwiches) onsite.

Evenings

Centre:

Dangun 39-41, St Nicholas Street, BS1 1TP. Cheap and delicious Korean/Asian Fusion food, good options for vegans too. <https://www.facebook.com/DangunBristol>

Bambalan on the Podium Level of Colston Tower, Colston Avenue Bristol, BS1 4XE. A lively venue for cocktails, mezze, burgers, babs (flatbreads with various toppings from tofu to meatballs), inside or outdoor terrace bar.

Tuk Tuk on the right-hand corner of 'the centre' at 5 St Stephen's Street BS1, does delicious Asian food, Katsu curry, noodles, dumplings, it is cheap and fresh. It's also tiny so be prepared to squeeze in on a side stool or queue.

Pieminister, 7 Broad Quay, BS1 4DA (in the centre), home of many lovely pies including vegan, and gluten free. Open until 11pm on Saturday. 9.30pm on Sundays. Another branch of Pieminister is on Stokes Croft, and also in St Nicholas Market.

Pho on the corner of Corn St and 28 Clare St, Bristol BS1 serves fresh, tasty Vietnamese food.

Beirut Mezze, 13A Small St, Bristol BS1 1DE, for a huge variety of Lebanese dishes, lots of veggie choices, grilled meats and fish, and set-price deals.

Franco Manca sourdough pizza, 16-22 Clare Street, Bristol BS1 1YG (at the bottom of Corn Street). Cheap and delicious, and they also do takeaway if you pre-order: <https://order.francomanca.co.uk/#>

Chilli Daddy 45-47 Baldwin Street BS1 for good Szechuan food, cheap noodles, dumplings, spare ribs etc. Gluten free and vegan options too. Open until 10pm Saturday.

riverstation, The Grove is expensive if you eat in the restaurant but cheaper if you eat downstairs in the bar (5-10pm), or on the outside deck if the weather is nice. A range of modern European dishes using local produce.

Mud Dock Café, 40 The Grove Bristol BS1 4RB. Just behind Arnolfini on the water. A range of food, falafel, steaks, salads, burgers, wraps, etc. Saturday 9am to 11pm, Sunday 10am to 5pm

Obento, Japanese restaurant on Baldwin Street does great Bento boxes, tempura and a wide choice of fresh sushi.

Urban Tandoor Indian restaurant, 13 Small Street Bristol BS1 1DE. Lovely fresh cooking and super naan breads! It is just off the centre on Small Street. Not cheap but delicious. Best to book in advance as it gets busy, 0117 929 9222. Also has a branch in Clifton on Whiteladies Road.

Renato's Taverna del Artista (33-34 King Street) does cheap, decent pizza and can accommodate a group quite easily if you get there early. It is very popular as it serves the theatre next door and has a late licence so people tend to crowd in there after hours.

Arnolfini and **Watershed** bars serve food, there are also numerous chain bistros/bars towards the Millennium Square area.

Park Street has numerous bars and places to eat. Boston Tea Party does good food until 8pm, also the usual chains and more as you wander up. Further up from Park Street, **Whiteladies Road and Cotham Hill** are chock full of restaurants and bars; **Flour and Ash; Muiño; Nomu; Bento Boss; Urban Kohinoor; SOUKITCHEN**. Buses go up Park Street and on to Whiteladies Road from College Green. **The Hope & Anchor**, 38 Jacobs Wells Rd, also does good beer and honest food, and has a small beer garden. The Grain Barge serves food and drink on the harbourside (on the bus route back into town).

Wapping Wharf has lots of lovely food options. If you walk behind MShed just over the water from Arnolfini there are little places in shipping containers, some pop-ups, some settled. **Salt & Malt** does delicious fish and chips, if you book ahead **BOX-E** has a reputation for outstanding food, **Gambas** for tapas, **Sholay Indian Kitchen, Woky Ko**, and many more options, check out the website for pop-ups: <http://wappingwharf.co.uk/bars-restaurants-cafes>

Bertha's Pizza, The Old Gaol Stables Cumberland Road BS1 6WW. Wood-oven sourdough pizza plus beer, wine and homemade gelato. Good for Veggies and Vegans. Eat in or takeaway.

SOUKITCHEN, 277 North St, Bristol, BS3 1JP. Eastern Mediterranean and Middle Eastern cooking.

Lounge, 227 - 231 North Street. Bar, Cafe, Vegan Options, Vegetarian Friendly, Gluten Free Options

The Malago, 220 North Street, Bristol BS3 1JD. Local cuisine, Bar, British, Vegetarian Friendly, Vegan Options.

Tobacco Factory. Bar / vegetarian food served Saturday until 9pm. Sunday until 8pm.

Coronation Curry House. 190 Coronation Road, Bristol BS3 1RF. Great Indian food, friendly staff. By the footbridge over the river to Spike Island.

El Rincón. 298 North Street, Bristol BS3 1JU. Until 10pm Sat, closed Sunday evening. Traditional Spanish food and drink, also a language school, tiny gig venue and offers accommodation.

The Clove, 5 Luckwell Road Ashton, Bristol BS3 3EL. Indian, Asian, Balti, Bangladeshi, Vegetarian Friendly

La Mediterranean, 242 North Street, Bristol BS3 1JD. Turkish Mediterranean food.

Yafo, 238 North Street, Southville, BS3 1JD – very nice vegetarian and vegan falafel restaurant.

Burger Joint, 240 North Street, Southville, BS3 1JD – very good gourmet burger restaurant.

Pizza Workshop, 232 North Street, Southville, BS3 1JD – good pizza restaurant, with takeaway.

Oowee, 202 North Street, Southville, BS3 1JF – dirty burger restaurant, with takeaway.

North Street Standard. 11-13 North Street, Bristol BS3 1EN. Local cuisine, Bar, British, Vegetarian Friendly, Vegan Options

Pony Bistro. 291 North Street, Bristol BS3 1JP. A new restaurant from Holly & Josh Eggleton. Reservations required - book way in advance (closed Sundays).

Sonny Stores. 47 Raleigh Road, Bristol, BS3 1QS. An Italian-influenced neighbourhood spot - restaurant and delicatessen - serving a daily changing seasonal menu. Reservations required - book way in advance (closed Sundays).

Drinks: Bristol Beer Factory, The Old Bookshop, The Cottage Inn, Nova Scotia, Tobacco Factory, The Spotted Cow, ...
